Discipleship Matters

We support a crisis pregnancy center in Revere, **Your Options Medical**, financially and in prayer. Please keep the many crisis pregnancy centers in your prayers right now. There are many pressures they currently face. The governing powers in MA seek to shut them down because they are pro-life centers and don't offer abortions.

Besides vandalism, there are concerted efforts through town ordinances and mis-information being used to pressure the existence of these centers that exist solely to help women and children. In 2022, the Somerville City Council passed an ordinance against crisis pregnancy centers within their city, falsely labeling them as deceptive, "limited-service centers" because they don't provide or refer for abortions. One councilwoman stated the position that you might hear on the news or in speeches. claimed pregnancy centers are "disingenuous" and accused them of withholding information about pregnancy and abortion from clients. She expressed that this ordinance will prevent Somerville residents from having to "deal with deceptive or misleading and manipulative language" that these pro-life centers supposedly share in their materials.

However, there's another side to this story, in 2022 alone, the <u>Pregnancy</u> <u>Care Alliance in Massachusetts</u>, (consisting of 15 pregnancy care centers), provided more than \$743,900 worth of material assistance to women such as diapers, wipes, clothing, car seats, cribs, food, and formula. They also provided nearly \$61,000 in pregnancy tests and more than half a million dollars in ultrasound exams.

Please pray for healthy conversations that support life, for God's protection over these pro-life care centers, for lawmakers to seek God's wisdom, for the women that receive support, and for the many precious lives of the de-
