I write to begin planning for a possible July 2024 trip to the Navajo, to spend time with, encourage and support Pastor Tim & Heidi, Leslie & Phillip at Shepard of the Valley in Navajo, NM.

How we might we be of benefit with a Mission's trip to the Navajo? Perhaps we provide a vacation bible school program, to help make the people aware of Gods' story of love for us, which is always welcome & eagerly anticipated by members of the church and children in the community.

We also can be of help to the church and the people by assisting with ongoing maintenance projects, on the church property and out in the community.

When? We are focusing on traveling during the second week of July, but these dates are flexible if the group decides otherwise. We are planning a week long trip. If you are interested in going and can identify dates and times which work for you and do not work for you throughout the month of July, please provide feedback via a reply.

Costs? We in the discovery phase. Expenses are for airfare, hotel, rental cars/vans, etc.

All these details to be worked out and discussed.
