- 2. Click SCHEDULES & PLANS on the left of screen.
- 3. Click MY SERVING on upper right of page under your photo.
- 4. Click on EDIT PREFERENCES on upper part of screen.
- 5. Click on BLOCKOUT DATES on upper part of screen.
- 6. Tap the first and last days you will be out.
- 7. Screen will show numerically your blocked out dates. **MAKE SURE TO CLICK SAVE** on the bottom right!
