A 4 week ZOOM group/study for a fresh look at the Incarnation of God the Son. Interested in growing in your understanding of what all of Scripture shares about this?

We'll explore how God had prepared His people well for the whole concept of Jesus being born. You might be familiar with a "prophecy" verses that come up each year in the lectionary.
