Here’s Why: the history of a midweek Lent worship service at night seems to have challenges for families; for those that don’t drive at night,; and with work hours.

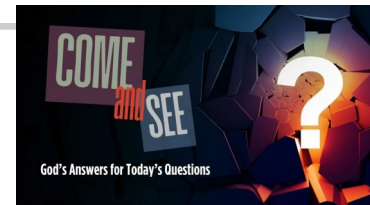
This program is an opportunity for us all to be intentional about “being church” together, in a user-friendly way this Lent.
