We are Juan and Megan Toledo. We are missionaries serving on a team with 6 others plus three children in the city of Salt, which is in the north of Jordan. My uncle and aunt will share more in a few weeks.

Just a little about our team. Our team vision: To see a movement to Christ of transformed and committed believers in Salt and among the tribes of the Gilead. Our team mission: to fully invest and engage in the community through various platforms using our gifts,

talents, and passions to see a Church Planting Movement take place.
