Dinner, Movie, and an Apologetics Discussion to follow

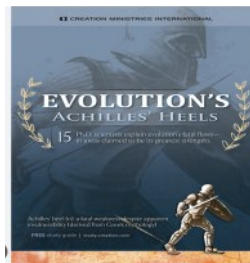
Title: *Evolution's Achilles Heel*
