Music Note from Wendy— on 8:15 music for LENT

Our Gradual for the five Sundays in Lent is LSB 422: *On My Heart Imprint Your Image*. The 40 days of Lent are about the faithful repeatedly asking God for a clean heart. "Create in me a clean heart, O God, and renew a right spirit within me." (*Psalms 51:10*). This hymn asks Him to continually imprint Himself on our hearts. The holy and solemn days of Lent prepare us for the summit of the church's year: the resurrection of our Lord, hearts inscribed with this truth: "Jesus, crucified for me, is my life, my hope's foundation, and my glory and salvation!"
