The Boston Bach Birthday is back!

BBB 341 will be held on **Saturday, March 21, 2026** at [First Lutheran Church in Boston](#). Organist and Bach Birthday artistic director **Jonathan Wessler** will kick the day off at 9am with a recital featuring all of Bach's organ concerto transcriptions. At 10am is the **Young People's Concert**, featuring youth from First Lutheran Church.

The music continues at 10:40am with organist **Savannah Curro** playing music of Bach and friends. This will be followed at 11:35am by a hymn sing featuring the hymns from Martin Luther's *German Mass* (which turns 500 years old this year), as well as two "new" Bach organ works that were discovered just a few months ago.

The famous German Lunch will be at noon—tickets are \$20 at the door.

Three solo instrumental programs follow lunch. Baroque pianist **Artem Belogurov** plays a program titled "In the Orbit of Bach" at 1:20pm, featuring music of Bach, his sons, and his students. At 2:20pm guitarist **Aaron Larget-Caplan** plays arrangements of Bach's music on guitar, and at 3pm violinist **Julia Connor** plays two Baroque violin suites.

Bach's festive cantata **Jauchzet Gott in allen Landen** will be performed at 3:40pm, complete with Baroque trumpet. The final recital of the day will be by international organist extraordinaire **Martin Schmeding**, who will play his transcription of Bach's Goldberg Variations at 4:05pm.

The order of **Vespers** at 5pm will close the day's festivities, featuring Bach's cantata on Psalm 130, *Aus der Tiefen rufe ich*.
